



# DRESS CODE 2017

We have recently revised our Dress Code to be more relaxed and in tune with current fashions. We do however request that our members and visitors respect this and help us maintain our standards.

## On the Course

- **Shoes** - proper golf with either hard or soft spikes or rubber pimple soles, must be worn. Trainers are not permitted.
- **Shirts** - With a collar attached or polo/turtle/crew/roll-neck golf shirt, all of which must be worn tucked in.
- **Shorts** - Tailored shorts may be worn, provided they are worn with socks of any length and colour. Combat or cargo shorts are not permitted.
- **Trousers** - Must not be tucked into socks unless covered by waterproof trousers. Denim jeans are not permitted.
- **Headwear** - Caps, if worn, must have the peak at the front.

## In the Lounge and Dining Room

**A clean, dry and presentable standard of dress is expected at all times.**

- **Shirts** - With a collar, may be worn tucked in or outside trousers.
- **Shorts** - Tailored or cargo shorts with visible socks. No combat or camouflage styles.
- **Denim Jeans** - Are permitted provided they are clean, presentable and not ripped or frayed.
- **Outerwear** - No waterproof clothing. No caps or hats.
- **Footwear** - Sandals and shoes may be worn with or without socks. No golf shoes or flip-flops.
- **Official functions** - Jackets and ties must be worn unless otherwise stated.

## Not permitted

- Collarless T-shirts
- Sleeveless vests
- Football/rugby shirts
- Tracksuit clothing
- Running shorts
- Combat/camouflage clothing
- Flip-flops
